"Surely he took up our pain and bore our suffering..." (Isaiah 53:4)

Isaiah does not describe Jesus watching from a distance. He says Jesus took up our pain and bore our suffering. That means He stepped into what weighs us down. He carried what we could not carry.

Verse 5 goes even deeper: "He was pierced for our transgressions; he was crushed for our iniquities." Our sin was not ignored. It was placed on Him. The punishment that brought us peace was on Him. That is why peace with God is possible. It was paid for.

Then Isaiah says, "We all, like sheep, have gone astray" (v.6). Every one of us has turned to our own way. Sin is not just a mistake. It is choosing our way over God's. Yet the verse does not end in failure. "The LORD has laid on him the iniquity of us all."

This is love that does not run away. Love that endures under pressure. Love that absorbs the cost.

When you feel guilty, remember: He carried it.

When you feel broken, remember: He was wounded so you could be healed.

When you feel lost, remember: He came looking for wandering sheep.

The cross proves that God did not love us at our best, but at our worst.

Today, stop carrying what Jesus already bore. Trust Him. Surrender your way to His and rest in the love that stayed.
