Psalm 34:3 - "O magnify the LORD with me, and let us exalt his name together."
David wrote these words during a difficult season of life. He was facing fear, uncertainty, and pressure, yet his focus remained on God rather than his problems. That is the challenge for every believer today.
Many people magnify trouble. They magnify stress, fear, disappointment, and negativity. The more we focus on problems, the larger they appear. David teaches us to shift our focus and magnify the Lord instead.
To magnify God does not mean making Him bigger, because God is already infinitely great. It means recognizing His greatness and helping others see Him more clearly through our worship, testimony, and faith.
A magnifying glass does not increase the size of an object; it simply reveals details more clearly. In the same way, our lives should reveal the greatness of God to others.
Even in difficult times, God remains worthy of praise. He is faithful, merciful, loving, and powerful. He has carried us through dangers seen and unseen. He has forgiven sins, answered prayers, and given hope through Jesus Christ.
David also said, *"Let us exalt his name together."* Worship was never meant to be isolated. God designed believers to encourage one another through praise and fellowship.
Today, choose to magnify God instead of your fears. When God becomes bigger in your heart, your problems become smaller in your spirit.
