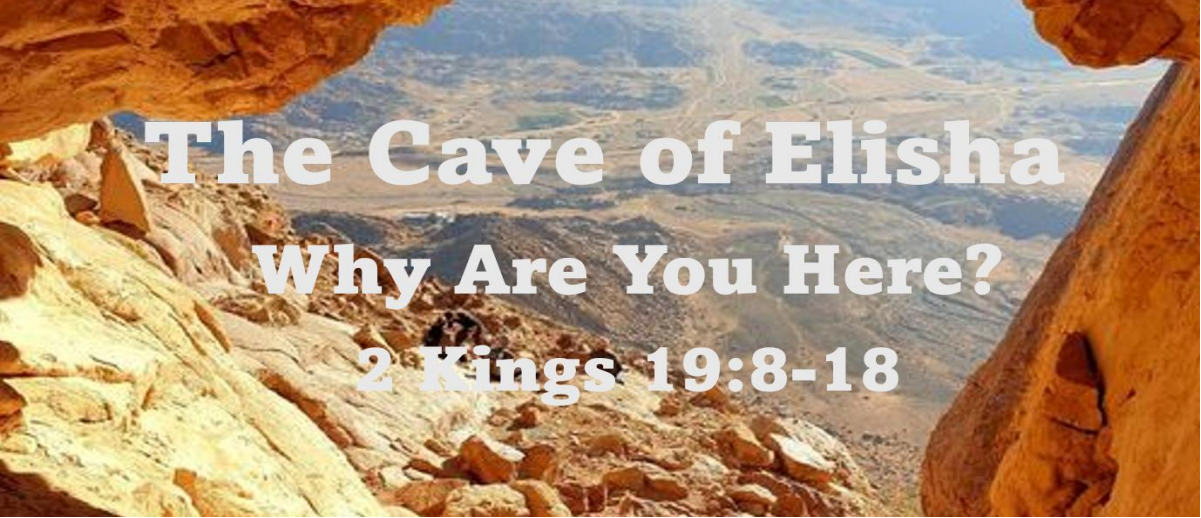

Have you ever felt like giving up? Elijah certainly did (1 Kings 19:1–18). Following one of the greatest victories of his ministry on Mount Carmel, he fled into the wilderness, discouraged and afraid. Hiding in a cave, he believed he was alone and that his work had accomplished nothing. God met Elijah with compassion rather than condemnation. Food, rest, and renewed strength came before correction. The Lord then asked a simple but profound question: "What are you doing here, Elijah?" God did not need information; Elijah needed reflection. After patiently listening to Elijah's frustrations, God spoke in a gentle whisper, reminding him that His presence is often experienced in quiet moments rather than dramatic displays of power. New assignments followed, along with the reassuring reminder that 7,000 faithful Israelites had remained loyal to Him. Elijah was not alone, and his work was far from finished. Many believers find themselves in caves of disappointment, fear, burnout, or discouragement. Feelings of failure or insignificance can cloud one's vision and weaken hope. God's question still echoes today: "What are you doing here?" The purpose of that question is not to shame but to restore and redirect. Discouragement does not cancel God's calling. The Lord still has work for you to accomplish, people for you to encourage, and opportunities for you to glorify Him.
